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The state of New Jersey, in the New Jersey Administrative Code 6A: 13-1.2(h), mandates that all public school districts have a SEPAC: "Each board of education shall ensure that a special education parent advisory Group is in place in the district to provide input to the district on issues concerning students with disabilities."
